BRIEF HISTORY OF CAMPUS



Indrachandra campus was established in 2070 B.S. by intellectually enthusiastic educators chipping in a fund to begin the college. In the initial phase, the campus was in the premises of Devi Ma.Vi. But due to some unavoidable circumstances, the administration was compelled to shift the campus to a rented building. The area wasn't adequate yet. Increment in the number of students showering their trust towards the campus, encouraged the administration to look for a long-term solution. Ultimately, the purchase of land at Syaldangi, Birtamode-6 Jhapa gave a way to run the campus in its own land. The successful construction of a four storey building inspired the vibrant team of ICCIAN to dream even bigger. As a result, another four storey building has also been constructed.

The achievements made in the educational sectors motivated many organizations and different forms of government in the following days. The minimum tuition fees collected from students are being economically used in administrative expenditures. - Have completed BBS or equivalent from recognized university,
- Must participate in entrance examination [CMAT]

Note: The candidate must satisfy any other entry requirements or criteria as prescribed by the Faculty Board or the campus for both admissions procedural.

EXAMINATION SYSTEM AND RESULTS



Internal examination are organized at least twice a year by examination committee. The students have to compulsorily attend the internal examinations. Examination committee is basically responsible for conducting and managing internal exams. Internal examinations schedules are set in the academic calendar of the campus. The final results of each year and semesters are analysed to see the improvements and weaknesses so that it will be beneficial to make future plan.

4. Students must cooperate each other for good relationship and etiquette
5. Students are advised to be disciplined within and outside the campus premises.
6. Students must respect the teachers and officials of college.
7. Students are requested to provide real facts as of date of birth, permanent address, mobile number, e-mail ID and related documents to get admission.

15. Students are not allowed to study admitted in another institute.
16. All students must come to the college in time. The late comers may not be allowed to enter the college.

18. Students must enter the college in proper uniform with identity card.
